



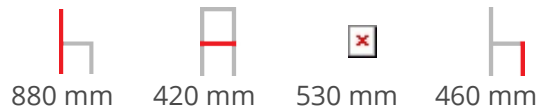
PRINCESS BENTWOOD CHAIR A-1840 UPH

European classic bentwood piece, first developed 1881. In 1861, a bent furniture plant was opened by Michael Thonet in Bystřice pod Hostýnem and today it is among the oldest in the world. The place was tactical, as it was surrounded by beech forests offering enough material for the manufacturing process, Bystřice pod Hostýnem also saved on transportation and labour costs thanks to its location.

A timeless icon of classic modern furniture, the classic bentwood range embodies the elegant simplicity of bentwood design, utilising traditional methods of European hand-craftsmanship and precision. Strong and durable with a timeless aesthetic, the classic bentwood is suitable for a variety of applications including cafes, restaurants and residential dining.

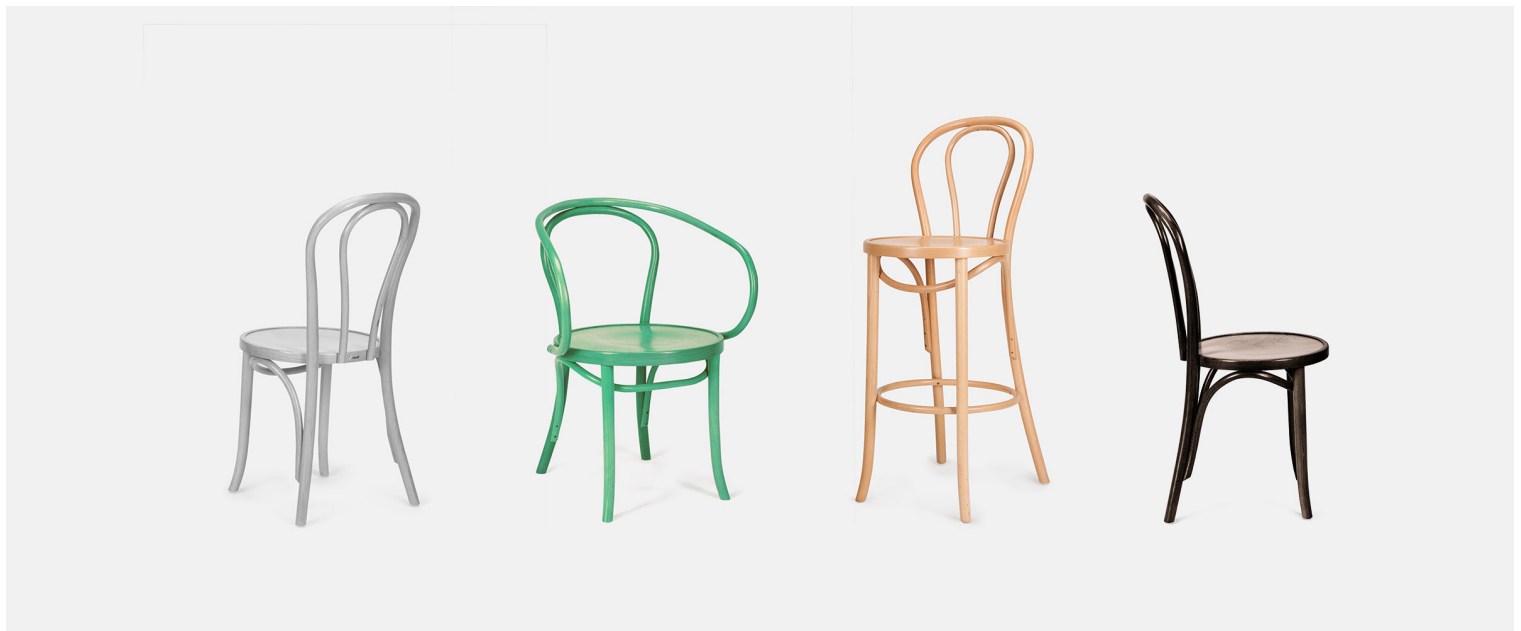

- **Floor protection:** glides matched to timber, tile, vinyl or carpet
- **Project supply:** volume quantities and staged deliveries for fit-outs

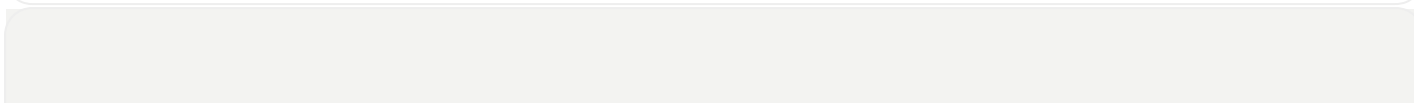

3. Steam bending and shape setting
4. Assembly, finishing (stain / varnish / enamel), then testing
